SONJA'S WINDOWS 1 Sew together assorted print 14" strips (a variety of widths, or all the same) in random order to make a 14" square If necessary, trim to 14" x 14" Make 10 pieced squares total 2 Place 1 square with strips going vertically right sides together a second square with strips going horizontally Stitch %" seam around all sides

T-Shirt Memory Quilt NOTE: If you make very many T-shirt quilts, it is worth investing in a heat press to save a lot of time when adding stabilizer to each shirt the attic window effect Cut enough squares to equal the number of T-shirt blocks you are using
