Suminagashi / Floating Ink Paper Marbling

Suminagashi (sue-me-NAH-gah-she), which means literally "ink-floating" involves doing just that Japanese Sumi-e inks were originally used, dropped carefully to float on a still water surface and then blown across to form delicate swirls, after which the ink was picked up by laying a sheet of white rice paper atop the ink covered water
