Procedural and surgical site infections create difficult and complex clinical scenarios A source for pathogens is often thought to be the skin surface, making skin preparation at the time of the procedure critical The most common skin preparation agents used today include products containing iodophors or chlorhexidine gluconate

MOHS MICROGRAPHIC SURGERY: PATIENT INFORMATION

The main difference between micrographic surgery and other methods of removing skin cancer is microscopic control In Mohs surgery, cancerous tissue is removed in thin horizontal layers Each layer is divided into sections, and each section is carefully identified and “mapped” by the surgeon so its exact location can be pinpointed on the wound

Modifiers 58, 78, and 79 - Staged, Related, and Unrelated ...

A Kenalog injection to the skin graft/flap site following Moh's surgery and flap repair is related This service is included in the global surgery package for the original surgery Do not report with modifier 79, 58, or any other modifier A skin lesion is removed with Mohs surgery and repaired with a skin graft (90-day global period)
